Notice is hereby given that **Liverpool City Council** intends to make the above-mentioned Order under **Section 14** of **The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended by **Section 1** and **Schedule 1** of **The Road Traffic [Temporary Restrictions] Act 1991**, in respect of a certain highway in the **Liverpool 17** area, to prohibit any pedestrian shall proceed on the footpath which runs from the south east side corner of the side to the north east corner on to **Riverside Drive**.

There will be no alternative route for pedestrian traffic.


All or part of these closures will only be implemented when deemed necessary by the Principal Contractor on site.

The Order is required to safely enable Langtree Group PLC to carry out regeneration works of the Garden festival site.

The Order shall come into operation from the 14th June 2010 up to and including the 29th June 2010, or such lesser time as determined by the earlier completion of the works.
